## SCOPE OF THE CONFERENCE

Its main aim is to provide a general forum for researchers, teachers and users from practice dealing with practical problems of control and ICT. Conference papers may range from highly theoretical works to industrial and engineering applications. Technical program will include invited talks of leading personalities in control engineering and applied informatics.
